More than 20 restaurants, 7 wineries, wine tasting sessions, jazz music, a giant slide and rides for the kids: a perfect cocktail for success for the inaugural Burwood Food and Wine Festival.

The Mayor of Burwood, Cr John Faker, is inviting everyone in the Inner West to take part at this great event: "Burwood Road is set to become alive with flavours from across the world: local eateries will join visiting wineries in giving the public the opportunity to taste the eclectic mix of dining experiences we have here in Burwood. The day will of course include entertainment for the children with a giant slide, bouncy castle and plenty of other activities for them to enjoy while you treat yourself to a day of fine wine and dining. So make sure you come along with your family and friends".

Burwood Road will be closed to traffic, and every winery will be clustered with different matching restaurants, surrounded by tables and chairs, offering a great view of elegant marquees, and a wonderful range of flavours to choose from.

Restaurants and Wineries

Delicious menus will be prepared by the following restaurants: Vee Vee's, Bello, Prego, Charcoal Chicks, George's Café, Café Marco, Gasparo, Café Dor, Gelatissimo, Sidnee's Café, New Fresh Chinese Restaurant, Food Garden Express, Ed's Peruvian, Master Gozlleme Turkish, Yans Asian, Radika Indian, Pukara Olives, Picon, Hontu Pancakes, Chee Meng Mongolian, Good Food international Sausages, Kalayan thai, Sherman Mini Dutch pancakes.

On the wine side, a few wineries will present their best drops: Benwarin Wines, Bunnamagoo Wines, Roselea Vineyard, Mount Vincent Estate, Peterson Wines, Swing Bridge, Little Winery.

Visitors will be able to purchase wine tokens and glasses from dedicated stalls (the price includes a token for the first tasting) and then wonder along Burwood Road, or just sit and absorb the atmosphere with a background of jazz music while the kids enjoy the rides.

Entertainment

The stage (set up at the centre of Burwood Road) will be taken by Casanovas Kiss, Sydney's most dynamic band. An experienced and entertaining band, Casanovas Kiss present seductive sounds and grooves, sure to please every visitor at the Festival

They won't be alone though: the wonderful guitarists from My Guitar School will entertain the audience with some wonderful re-arrangements of the greatest hits from the Beatles to Santana, so make sure you don't miss them!

Roaming performers will complete the show.

Wine appreciation sessions

For the most passionate palates, Burwood Food and Wine Festival offers a great opportunity to be guided by a wine expert through a real wine appreciation experience!

A special marquee (set at the corner of Burwood Road and Burwood Park) will be dedicated to wine tasting. Winemaster Paul Foster will guide small wine appreciation session (30 people, 4 times during the day). Limited seats, early booking available on 9960 1733.

Paul Foster's world is wine. He talks, teaches, judges and writes about it. He works as a consultant to both trade and the public and over an extended career has won several awards. Paul Foster is also one of the original architects of the Young Australian Winemaker of the Year Award. His duty, as he sees it, is to "educate and to enthuse others about the magic of fine wine".

Kids and rides

A giant 33 meters slide will be available on Burwood Road, together with some awesome inflatables. The corner of Burwood Park (in front of Westfield) will also be dedicated to the younger ones, with lots of rides and jumping castles. So bring the family along.
